_____ I understand that students do not receive formal English Language Arts instruction until the 2nd grade

_____ I understand that Math, Social Studies, Science and other core curricula subjects are taught in French or Spanish until students reach the 6th grade

_____ I understand that while teachers are certified in their native countries and many are sent to us via Louisiana government initiatives such as CODOFIL, each teacher's English proficiency may vary

_____ I understand that my child may not enter one target language program and then switch to the other target language mid-year or any subsequent academic year. If you wish to attempt changing your language selection after enrollment you must go through standard admissions procedures including timely submission of an application and entrance observation or exam and/or language fluency exam.

_____ I understand that each family is required to contribute a minimum of 20 hours of volunteer service during the school year.

_____ I understand that I must live in the state of Louisiana in order to register my child for school. If I cannot provide proof of residency by the first day of school, placement in the school will be withdrawn immediately and offered to a Louisiana state resident.
