It is the goal of the International School of Louisiana and the Jefferson Parish Public School System (JPPSS) that all students are enrolled in a school that meets the needs of their family for the 2017-2018 school year. In an effort to assist, ISL is working closely with JPPSS during this transition.

JPPSS has requested a visit to our campus in upcoming weeks to work with families interested in remaining in a Jefferson Parish public school.

During this JPPSS visit, they would offer the following:

- Provide ISL-JP families with general information about JPPSS
- Assistance with neighborhood options for JP residents
- JPPSS has also stated they will extend the application deadline to their magnet schools for current ISL-JP students. They would be available to answer questions and provide information about this option as well.

The date and time of the JPPSS representatives visit will be provided to parents on the campus web page, sent via email, and posted in the Tidbits. You do not need to do anything additional at this time.

For ISL-JP families who choose to continue with ISL, we welcome you and encourage you to stay informed. At the appropriate time, all ISL families must follow the annual process for intent to return/withdraw process. ISL Admissions staff will reach out to ISL-JP parents with details and specific information and instructions regarding the transition. Please understand Enroll NOLA and OneApp outline the process and procedures. When we are ready to make this transition, you will be notified.
